REFERENDUM

REZONINGS AND COMPREHENSIVE PLAN AMENDMENTS REQUIRE APPROVAL OF FOUR MEMBERS OF TOWN COUNCIL

Should the Charter be amended to require an affirmative vote of at least four members of Town Council for adoption of all proposed rezonings not subject to quasi-judicial proceedings, comprehensive land use plan, and comprehensive plan amendments?

VIA PETITION, CITIZENS MAY INITIATE ORDINANCES AND REQUIRE RECONSIDERATION OF ADOPTED ORDINANCE; REFERENDUM

Shall the Charter be amended to allow citizens, by petition of 15 percent of the registered Town voters, to propose an ordinance, or require Council to reconsider an adopted ordinance, and, if Council fails to adopt the proposed ordinance or repeal an ordinance, the proposed ordinance or repeal of an ordinance will be voted upon by Town citizens?
